

Job Title: Survivorship Care Programme Manager

Job Description:

We are seeking a motivated Epidemiologist with experience in the Oncology field to support the team of Dr. Alexia F. Bertuzzi in the implementation of Task 7.3 “Development of integrative survivorship care programme”, within the scope of the EU-funded project “Joint Action on Networks of Expertise on Cancer” (JANE-2, project no. 101183265). The forementioned Task entails the development of a comprehensive survivorship care programme, aimed at the prevention and management of late effects in cancer survivors, encompassing evidence-based health determinants, lifestyle, and psychosocial factors. Specifically, the post holder is expected to lay the groundwork for the development of a software tool supporting clinical decision-making by assuming literature-based rules.

Key Responsibilities:

- **Conducting a systematic review** to evaluate the most relevant long-term side effects, defined as evidence-based health determinants (age-related chronic medical conditions, physical effects of treatment and cancer, risk of recurrence).
- **Translating findings into actionable “rules”** for stratifying and classifying cancer survivors by risk, supporting the development of personalised follow-up care plans.
- **Developing an algorithm** able to stratify cancer survivors based on their risk of developing long-term adverse effects and provide individualized follow-up plans.
- **Working in a multi-disciplinary team**, including clinical researchers and software developers.
- **Delivering reports and presentations** to both national and international audiences.

Qualifications and Skills

- Master’s degree/PhD in Epidemiology/Public Health/Medical Statistics, or a related field.
- Proven experience in conducting scoping/systematic reviews and evidence synthesis, in the field of oncology.
- Proficiency in systematic review tools (e.g., EndNote, Covidence) and statistical software (e.g., R, Stata).
- Familiarity with guideline development processes and risk stratification frameworks.
- Proficiency in English, written and spoken

- Good organizational and problem-solving skills.
