Job Title: EUNetCCC Legal Expert

Context and Role:

The European Network of Comprehensive Cancer Centres (EUNetCCC) is a Joint Action funded under the EU4Health programme, a key initiative stemming from the Europe's Beating Cancer Plan – Flagship 5. The main objective of project is to create a European network of Comprehensive Cancer Centres (CCCs). By 2030, the initiative aims to ensure that 90% of eligible patients have access to a CCC and improve access to high-quality care close to home.

As part of this initiative, ACC leads Work Package 7 (WP7), which is responsible for developing and implementing the governance framework for the future Network.

We are looking for a legal expert with solid experience in European and international law to support the identification and definition of the most appropriate legal form for the new European network. The consultant will be responsible for analysing the different legal options available and providing clear and reasoned recommendations.

Key Responsibilities:

- Mapping of the legal forms under European and Member State legislation suitable for networks or consortia with independent legal personality and a designated legal representative.
- Mapping of the potential legal forms that the EUNetCCC network may adopt, based on a survey of comparable structures and including an in-depth analysis of the governance and operational characteristics of the networks identified as most relevant for the purposes.
- Assessment of the legal and fiscal frameworks of the countries in which establishing the network would be most appropriate, including an evaluation of the associated timelines and costs.

- Provision of support for the drafting of the Statute of the CCC network (optional, contingent upon the Joint Action's decision to proceed).

Requirements and Competencies

- Master's degree in law (or equivalent) with specialization in European law, corporate law, or international law.
- Proven experience in advising on or establishing European or international legal entities, preferably in the health or research sector.
- Familiarity with EU-funded programmes, in particular **EU4Health** and **Horizon Europe**, or similar programmes.
- Excellent analytical and communication skills.
- Excellent command of English, both written and spoken (minimum level C1).

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience working with transnational networks, consortia, or alliances in the health or scientific sector.
- Knowledge of legal and governance issues related to European networks or institutions.
